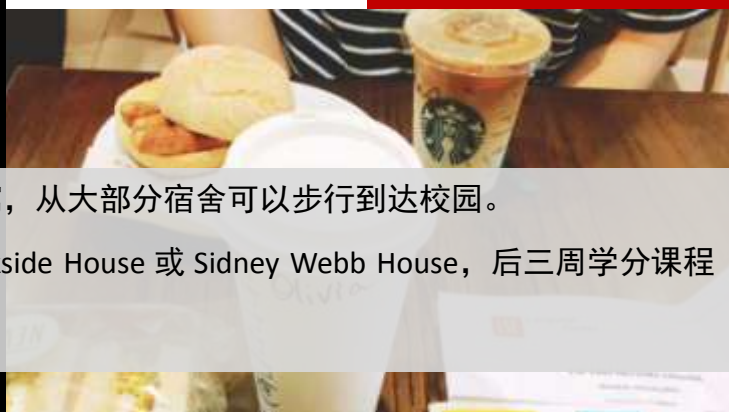
暑假课程同时面向本校生和国际学生，有一定的学术难度。

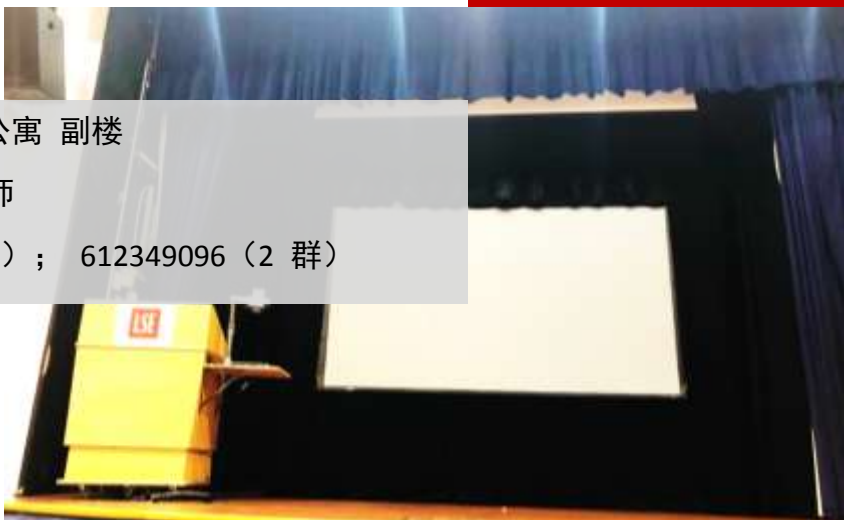
