Experience University Research (EUR)

EUR daily classes include approximately 1.5 hours for **Advanced Writing Composition** and approximately 1.5 hours for **Global Communication Skills**.

Students will have a choice of **University Elective** (2 units, 20 hours) taught by UCI faculty and field experts.

Academic disciplines

may include *Engineering, Social Ecology, Business, Finance, Game Design, Programming, Bio Business Enterprise and Fashion Design*.

Groups of 3-5 students will meet with **Conversation Partners** approximately 6 hours/week to practice English and learn about American university life.

Students will also learn about UC admissions, majors, and facilities through custom **Presentations** and **Tours**.

General Information:

1. Students will have access to **UCI libraries, computers**, etc. and receive a University **Division of Continuing Education ID card**, which can be used to obtain a **Photo ID Card** at UC Items if desired.
2. UC Irvine has campus **Wi-Fi** available (**FREE**) for those who bring their Laptop/ Notebook Computers. **UCI computers** are available in various locations around the campus and in the Main Library.
3. UC Irvine will have **Optional Activities** finalized before the courses begin. These activities might include Disneyland, Universal Studios, Surfing Lessons, Professional Sports, Musicals, etc. Students can pay fees for Activities upon arrival and on a first-come, first-served basis.
4. Students will have the opportunity to participate in **FREE Activities** throughout the program, such as sports with international students, dance workshops, and more. The Activities staff can also suggest good places to shop, concerts, sports, etc. Information will be available upon arrival during the orientation and at the Activities Desk.
